**RE 2012 SAN DIEGO CIF BASKETBALL PLAYOFFS PRESENTED BY
FARMERS INSURANCE GROUP**

1. **OFFICIAL PLAYOFF BASKETBALL**

Rawlings has graciously entered into an agreement with the San Diego Section. **Rawlings** will be providing all the section playoff basketballs and will be the Official Basketball for the **2012** San Diego CIF Section Basketball Playoffs. **Spalding** is the official ball for the State CIF Regional Championships, and State CIF Finals.

2. **FORMAT**

Playoffs will be conducted in five divisions. A maximum of 66 percent (two-thirds) of the eligible teams in each enrollment division for both men and women shall be selected to participate. Schools will be divided into five enrollment divisions (I, II, III, IV, V). 2012 October CBED enrollments will be used in grades 9-12 and are defined by the State CIF. League Champions (not co-champions or tri-champions) will be guaranteed entry. All other berths will be filled with at-large selections according to the results of the pairings meeting.

3. **PAIRINGS**

- The Commissioner's office will seed teams and determine first round pairings after input from the Basketball Pairings Committees. There will be no appeal from the Commissioner's decisions on seeding or pairings.
- League champions (designated #1) are automatic entries into the playoffs. All others, including co-champions or tri-champions, will be selected at large.
- League champions or designated #1 teams will be guaranteed a home game in the first round (unless meeting another #1 team) but are not guaranteed a seeding priority.

4. **PAIRINGS MEETINGS – DIVISION I-V (BOYS AND GIRLS)**

Pairings meetings for playoff teams will be conducted on Saturday, February 18, 2012 at San Diego County Office of Education, Conference Room; GIRLS' at 8:30 a.m.; BOYS' at 11:15 a.m.

CIFSDS Season Record Form; Team Picture Identification sheet; and Program Information Form must arrive at the CIFSDS office by 12:00 P.M. on Saturday, February 11, 2012. Failure to do so **will remove your team from consideration for the playoffs. Team photo/roster must be email to Section Sports no later than February 18 - sds@sectionsports.net.**

Pairings will be announced on Saturday, February 18, Room 505 at SDCOE (CIF office) Girls' teams at 11:15 a.m.; Boys' teams at 1:30 p.m. Rawlings basketballs will be distributed to teams in the playoffs along with additional playoff items.

NOTE: Please make arrangements with your school administration to attend!

From the North: Use I-5 South, exit Sea World Dr./Tecolote Rd. and proceed left at stoplight toward Morena Blvd. Turn right on Morena, left on Napa, and left on Linda Vista Rd. Travel to the second stoplight to USD's east entrance, turn left and enter campus.

From the South (or the airport): Use I-5 North, exit Morena Blvd. (signs will say: Morena Blvd. use I-8 East) Stay to the right and follow the signs for Morena Blvd. Take the first right onto Linda Vista Rd. Travel to the third stoplight to USD's east entrance, turn left and enter campus.

From the East: Use I-8 West, exit at Morena Blvd., go right onto Linda Vista Rd. and travel to the third stoplight to USD's east entrance, turn left and enter campus.

From the airport: **The campus is a 10-minute cab ride (approximately \$15.00).**

6. **SITE MANAGEMENT**

First Round, Quarterfinals, and Semifinals - Home Team
Championship - CIFSDS Office and host site, unless otherwise provided.

7. **SCHOOL SUPERVISION**

School supervision is required at every level of playoff contests (home and away). It is recommended that the following should be present: school administration, five (5) administrative supervisors, teacher/campus assistants, and private security (as needed).

8. **SPECIAL AWARDS**

It is inappropriate for individual schools to recognize their student-athletes during CIFSDS playoff contests; i.e., senior awards, flower distribution, etc.

9. **VIDEOTAPING**

Videotaping of CIFSDS playoff contests by schools for commercial use is not allowed.

10. **PRE-GAME SPORTSMANSHIP MEETING**

Sportsmanship Meeting to be conducted by the Home Team (or highest seed) Management prior to all playoff games, except Championship Final. (meeting sample attached to coach's copy and athletic director's copy only).

11. **ADMISSION PRICES**

There are two playoff ticket ranges – Adult = Defined as anyone over 18 years old, and Student/Senior = Student defined as anyone age 5 through age 18; Senior defined as anyone age 60 or over. Children under 5 will be admitted free of charge.

PLAYOFF PASS: Playoff Passes are now available at the CIFSDS Office for Boys’ and Girls’ Basketball – one pass \$27.00; additional pass(es) \$23.00 (limit of 3).

12. **AWARDS**

There will be Boys’ and Girls’ Division I-V team trophies for the San Diego CIF Championship and Runner-up team together with 17 individual championship patches each for Division I-V team member and 17 individual silver medals each for Division I-V runners-up team member.

13. **OFFICIALS**

All playoff officials shall be assigned by Richard Davila, Paul Packard and Ric Labrada, the CIFSDS Basketball Assignment Secretaries. **Home school must pay officials for all first round, quarterfinal, and semifinal** playoffs and shall list them as an expense item for contests where admission is charged. Officials for Championship will be paid by the CIFSDS Office.

14. **ACCOMMODATIONS FOR OFFICIALS**

Coaches and Athletic Directors are asked to continue their efforts to provide professional assistance to officials who work their games. This would include meeting the officials upon arrival and escorting them to their dressing area as well as escorting them off the court at the contest’s conclusion. School personnel other than the head coach should be designated to stand by with a key to the official’s room, or the officials should be given a key. On-site staff should be aware of and observe the privacy of the officials’ locker room/dressing area. Thank you for your cooperation.

15. **TICKETS**

First Round, Quarterfinals, and Semifinals

The home school will provide tickets. (See Green Book, Policies and Procedures,). Ticket Control Form and Guidelines- Other Sports are available on the CIFSDS web site at www.cifsd.org - FORMS – Financial Playoff Forms.

NOTE: Schools may use the CIFSDS Pass List for complimentary entry to first round, quarterfinal, and semifinal games. Complimentary List form is on the CIFSDS web site at www.cifsd.org - FORMS –Financial Playoff Forms. Each school is allowed twenty (20) complimentary admissions. The visiting school will fax its pass list to the home school and to the CIFSDS Office. The home school will fax its list to the CIFSDS Office. CIFSDS fax number is 858-292-1375.

Finals – CIFSDS will host the finals. Twenty (20) complimentary tickets will be available to each participating school and may be obtained from the CIFSDS Office.

16. **GAME EXPENSE LIMITS**

Game expense limits are found in the Green Book, Policies and Procedures, page 12-13. Playoff Report; Guidelines Sports, and Supervision Form are available on CIFSDS web site at www.cifsd.org - FORMS – Financial Playoff Forms.

17. **PASSES**

No deviation shall be permitted from the following:

Permitted CIFSDS Courtesy Cards, CIFSDS Playoff Passes, CIFSDS Boys’/Girls’ Basketball Playoff Scouting Cards (except for Championships), CIFSDS Media Passes, and CIFSDS Life Passes, State CIF Courtesy Cards, and State CIF Life Passes.

Not Permitted Boys’ and Girls’ Scouting Cards, league passes, district passes, faculty passes, officials’ association passes, college or university passes, etc. Bus drivers are not admitted without a ticket.

NOTE: TWO (2) Boys’ and Girls’ Basketball Playoff Scouting Passes will be issued to each team at the pairings announcement on, **Saturday, February 18, 2012**

18. **CHEERLEADERS**
A **maximum of 25 varsity cheer or song leaders per school**, in uniform, will be permitted to enter free of charge at all contests where admission is charged.
19. **PEP BAND**
Complimentary admission may be given to pep bands in accordance with the following criteria:
 a. Permission must be secured in advance from game management.
 b. Pep bands shall be limited to no more than 18 members, in uniform.
 c. Each member must enter with his/her own instrument.
 d. To secure complimentary admission, the band must enter as a single group accompanied by an adult band director.
 e. The pep band may not perform (play) during game action.
 f. The band must sit in area designated by game management.
20. **RADIO AND TV COVERAGE**
Radio and TV rights to all San Diego Section playoff contests are governed by the CIFSDS Office. Please refer to the fee schedule on pages 11-12 in Policies and Procedures section of Green Book. Home schools may handle arrangements for the First Round, Quarterfinal, and Semifinals without contacting the CIFSDS Office. Checks for radio and TV coverage in pre-final rounds are to be made payable to the home school and are to be listed as income on the financial report. Finals arrangements are to be handled by the CIFSDS Office and all requests are to be referred to the Commissioner or Assistant Commissioner.
21. **UNIFORMS**
Home teams in the playoffs are to wear light uniforms with dark uniforms prescribed for visiting teams, unless mutually agreed otherwise in advance.
22. **NON-FOOD CONCESSION**
The non-food concession (e.g., T-shirts, hats, visors, etc.) has been awarded to **The Kukulski Bros.** for the **2012** playoffs. If you have any special ordering needs, contact David Kukulski at 480-921-1975.
23. **2012 PROGRAM CONCESSION**
Section Sports has been awarded the 2012 championship program concession. It is mandatory that you submit a completed copy of the Roster/Record attachments (coach/AD copies of this bulletin) **and a team photo**. Photos and rosters are to be emailed by **February 17** to **sds@sectionsports.net**.
