

With the SCGA transition in handicap vendors there are some major changes to procedures for recording scores this year. Please read the information below carefully and contact your league representative if you have any questions.

STUDENTS ARE NOT TO POST SCORES ONLINE FROM SEPTEMBER 1 – OCTOBER 22, 2010. Failure to comply with this may result in the disqualification for CIF. Please remind the students any rounds played outside of the school matches are to be posted at the golf course computer. Only coaches are to post scores online to a player's file during the season.

Find Your Roster

1. Go to the CIF website, www.cifsd.org, and print out a list of your current player's with their SCGA membership number. ALL membership numbers have changed. Verify the spelling and school code identifier for your player's. There is a list of members at the end who do not have a school code identifier. Player's must be identified to a school in order to be considered for CIF.
2. Any player's not listed on the roster will need a new membership application filled out. The application is available for printing off the CIF website, www.cifsd.org. Applications for brand new golfers must be sent to John Morello at San Marcos High School by **Friday, September 10, 2010.**

*Birth dates for all players are required on the membership application.

3. A new list of player's with membership numbers will be available every Monday evening.
4. To delete any players who are no longer part of the team, please print out a copy of your school roster and draw a line through any names of players to be deleted. Lists may be faxed to (818) 980-5019 Attention: Fran Nee. Or you may email any names of players to be deleted from your school to Fran Nee at fnee@scga.org.

Posting Scores

1. Score posting will begin on Wednesday, September 1, 2010.
2. Post all scores by the Saturday following a match. ALL final scores must be posted by midnight on **Friday, October 22nd**. No exceptions.
3. If a player currently has an SCGA number you can begin posting scores immediately. You will need to have the golfer's seven digit number and last name. Passwords are no longer needed.
4. All scores are to be entered as 9 hole scores. If an 18 hole match is played you will need to enter the score as two 9 hole scores to be considered for CIF.
5. To post a score please go to www.scga.org and select Post A Score under My SCGA on the right hand side of the home page. You will then need to enter the player's SCGA/GHIN number and last name. Important – use the real last name of the player listed on your roster, not the school code as previously done. Select the date of the round, leave type of game as Away, change the Holes to 9 Holes by using the drop down, select the state where the course is located (CA) and then select the letter of the alphabet the course name begins with. From there you will be given the option to post scores to the 9 hole ratings that correspond to the tees played.
6. A warning may come up if a score being posted is out of the golfer's range. Verify the scoring information and if it is correct contact your league representative to have them post the score.
7. If you do not see the correct ratings for the tees played DO NOT post the score. Please contact Fran Nee at the SCGA office to get the correct ratings. (800) 913-7242 x314 or fnee@scga.org

Reviewing Posted Scores

1. The new Handicap Index is available on the 1st and 15th of each month.
2. Once two nine hole scores have been posted they will be combined into the 18 hole score file. The independent 9 hole scores will not be available for viewing.
