**RE: 2017 CIF SAN DIEGO DUAL MEET WRESTLING CHAMPIONSHIP**

**1. QUALIFYING**

**All schools that field 2017 varsity wrestling teams will be separated into Divisions I-IV.**

**Pairing will be established by the Commissioners' Office at the pairings meeting to be held at the CIFSDS office on Monday, January 30, 2017, at 1:00 p.m. The committee will consider the following criteria when considering the teams:**

- **Strength of schedule**
- **Dual meet records**
- **League Champions**
- **Tournament records**
- **Overall record**
- **Committee recommendations**

**2. TOURNAMENT INFORMATION**

1. Schools with wrestling teams will be divided into Division I, Division II, Division III, and Division IV.
2. The Top 6 teams per division (determined by and seeded by a CIF appointed committee) will participate.
3. Host school to provide responsible table help, custodial/security personnel, an announcer, and accommodations for the officials working the match.
4. The official weigh-in shall be conducted on certified scales provided by the home team. All matches (Quarter-Finals, Semi-Finals, and Finals/3<sup>rd</sup> Place) will be wrestled on the same day (February 11, 2017). Division 1 and Division 3 Championships will

be held at Mira Mesa. Division 2 and Division 4 Championships will be held at Rancho Bernardo HS. Each host site will use four mats.

5. This championship series is single elimination (with the exception of the teams that wrestle for 3<sup>rd</sup> Place).

**Quarterfinals: Round 1 (On all four mats)**

- In ROUND 1 the top 2 seeded teams per division will have a bye, while 3 wrestles 6 and 4 wrestles 5.
- Only the winning teams advance to the next round.

**Semifinals: Round 2 (On all four mats)**

- The semifinal matches for both divisions will run concurrently using all four mats.
- The winner of 4 vs 5 will wrestle 1, and the winner of 3 vs 6 will wrestle 2.
- The winning teams advance to the finals. The other teams will wrestle for third place.

**Finals/3<sup>rd</sup> Place: Round 3 (On all four mats)**

- The semifinal winners will wrestle for the championships in both divisions concurrently with the semifinal losers in both divisions wrestling for 3<sup>rd</sup> Place.
- Only the Championship teams and the Runner Up teams will receive awards.

**3. WEIGH-IN RULES (for CIF Dual Meet Championships)**

1. THE NWCA TEAM WEIGH-IN FORM MUST BE PRESENTED TO THE HEAD WEIGH-IN OFFICIAL PRIOR TO WEIGH-INS.
2. Weigh-ins will follow the NFHS dual meet weigh-in procedures (Rule 4 – Section 4 – Art. 1- 4, Rule 4 – Section 5 – Art. 1, Art. 3-4, Art. 7-9, on pages 18-19 in the NFHS Wrestling Rules Book).

3. Using multiple certified scales, all wrestlers will be weighed in by team. Each school may weigh-in a maximum of 20 wrestlers.
4. Each competing wrestler may step on the scale a maximum of TWO times in an attempt to make his weight. If needed, a wrestler may challenge any additional scale being used during weigh-ins.
5. Weigh-ins shall begin at the designated time and conclude when the last team has been certified. Any wrestler NOT in the weigh-in room at the designated start time will be disqualified – NO EXCEPTIONS. It is the COACHES' RESPONSIBILITY to understand and adhere to these NFHS rules.

**4. AWARDS**

Team trophies will be awarded to the Championship and Runner-up teams in Division I through

IV. Individual CIFSDS patches (25) will be given to members of the divisional championship team, and individual runner up patches (25) will be given to members of the runner-up team in all four divisions. Awards will be presented immediately following the final match.

**5. ADMISSION**

There are two playoff ticket ranges: **Adult** – Defined as anyone over 18 years old, and **Student/Senior** – Student defined as anyone age 5 through age 18; Senior defined as anyone age 60 and over.

The CIFSDS Office will provide the tickets for the CIF Dual Meet Championships.

**7. PASSES -No deviation from the following shall be allowed:**

- PERMITTED - CIFSDS Courtesy Cards, CIFSDS Playoff Passes, CIFSDS Media Passes.
- NOT PERMITTED - CIFSDS Boys' and Girls' Scouting Passes, league passes, district passes, faculty passes, officials' association passes, college or university passes, etc.

**8. OFFICIALS**

Match officials will be assigned by Mark Dexter (SDWOA) and Dale Ramey (IVWOA). Playoff Report Forms are available on CIFSDS Home Site; please visit the website at [www.cifsds.org](http://www.cifsds.org) Officials are a deductible expense for the host site in all rounds.

**9. CHEERLEADERS**

A maximum of 25 uniformed varsity cheerleaders, representing the competing schools will be admitted free of charge to all CIFSDS playoff contests.

**10. FOOD CONCESSION**

The host site has approval to provide concession stands for the event.

**11. SPIRIT SIGNS**

Prior to hanging spirit signs, permission must have been granted from tournament/school site administration. Reminder that all signs, posters, banners, etc., by each competing school are to be utilized for the purpose of promoting its own team rather than downgrading its opponent. Therefore, no signs, banners, etc., will be permitted that refer to an opponent except in a positive manner. Blue tape must be used on painted walls.
