



**Men's Golf Post -Season  
Advisory Meeting  
May 30 ,2019**

Meeting took place at the CIFSDS office on May 20, 2019, at 4:00 p.m.

**General Information and concerns:**

- ❖ Coach of the year was selected and was Casey Sovacool from La Costa Canyon
- ❖ Player of the Year was selected and that was Kento Yamawaki from La Costa Canyon
- ❖ Discussion took place over the team regional tie breakers the committee asked that the following wording be added to the Green Book under golf to address these situations.
  1. For ties for first place or for qualifying for regionals. First, we will go to the 6<sup>th</sup> card on the 2<sup>nd</sup> day, if still tied then there will be a team playoff starting backwards from hole 18 until there is a winner.
  2. For team ties for second place. First we will go to the 6<sup>th</sup> card on the 2<sup>nd</sup> day if still tied then it it will go to a card off of all 6 players WE will look at holes 16,17 and 18 and take the top 5 scores. If still tied we will look at the 6<sup>th</sup> man. If still tied we go back 3 more holes until a tie is broken.
  3. Beginning next season their will be a playoff for the 13 spot, if there is a tie for that spot, for qualifying for regionals in the

event that a player withdraws they would be the first alternate to advance.

- ❖ Discussion also took place on the following matters; Player disqualifications and waivers and eligibility.
- ❖ In regards to DQ's the discussion centered around a player DQ to avoid a bad score. After discussion it was decided to add the following language to the section Green Book:
  1. If the offense is considered an ethics or behavior violation then that student would be suspended for the duration of that contest plus the next one. Notification would need to be sent to the section office that a player was ejected for this offense.
  2. If the offense is after the round has been played then the score should be posted and the student athlete can be suspended for one game or more depending on the severity of the offense.
  3. Please note this is a high school event no wagering on the results of a specific hole or outcome of the contest is allowed and may be considered an ethics violation and result in a DQ or suspension for one game.
- ❖ Once you leave the course the results are final and there is a stroke penalty for signing your card with the wrong score posted. The student athlete is not DQ'd from the match but simply penalized with the 2-stroke penalty to their correct score.
- ❖ Discussion took place around the waivers and why coaches are not getting their student athletes the number of matches required to participate in the section playoffs. The north county conference has a proposal to do away with the waivers for student athletes that use them for eligibility and for the SOP.
  1. It was noted the section office does not support this. The fact that we do not regulate how coaches schedule and ineligible athletes join their teams in every other sport without having to work with waivers. Waivers were put into place to make sure student athletes that can participate as unattached athletes are required

to play matches for their high school and not simply join them for the playoffs.

2. Further discussions centered around transfers and the SOP and clarifications were made regarding the process and the facts that parents and students are making more moves throughout the county. Additionally it was noted that within school districts students have the ability to choose where they want to go now. School of choice is here and with that comes movement of students and student athletes.
