Tournament Information

Matches will be played on February 23, 2019 at Valhalla & Granite Hills High Schools. Courts will be available starting at 8 AM for warm up. All teams must arrive by 8:30; matches start at 9 AM.

Entries & Classification

This event is designed for non-ranked players that are competing on a high school tennis team. None of the players on the team may have been ranked in the top 150 in the SCTA rankings for the past two years (final ranking). The Tournament Committee reserves the right to disqualify any player for any reason. Each team will consist of a t l e a s t 9 players. Each school will be guaranteed to compete in at least 3 tennis matches.

Format

This is a dual match team tournament. Each team will have 3 singles players and 3 doubles teams. Each member of the team will play the corresponding player from the other team #1 vs #1, #2 vs #2, and #3 vs #3. Each set will be first to 6 games with a tiebreaker at 5-5. The winner will be the team winning the most games, if still a tie, then most sets won.



Rules

USTA and CIF Rules will govern play during the tournament. **Each match played in this event WILL count as one point of your 24 matches permitted per season.**

Inclement Weather

If rain should postpone any matches, it is the coaches' responsibility to contact the tournament.
