1. IMPORTANT NOTICE:

THE FOLLOWING WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED AT THE DIVISIONALS MEETS. DO NOT RISK FORFEIT OF YOUR ATHLETES AND TEAM BY NOT ADHERING TO STATE WRESTLING BYLAW 3103. THANK YOU FOR YOUR COOPERATION.

- A.** All CIF member schools must follow all National Federation (NFHS) rules and procedures concerning the weighing in of wrestlers.
- B.** California provides 14 weight classes per NFHS rules and the two (2)-pound growth allowance*¹ to each weight class after January 15 (approved February 1997 Federated Council - also see NFHS Wrestling Rules Book 4-4).
- C.** Each team is required to bring his/her team's NWCA forms to all competitions, including the CIF State Wrestling Championships.
- D.** Each is required to weigh in with its NWCA Plan form at all competitions up to and including the competition that begins the CIF State Championship qualifying series.
PENALTY: FAILURE TO COMPLY WILL RESULT IN THE WRESTLER BEING INELIGIBLE FOR THAT COMPETITION (Revised May 2007 Federated Council).

Growth Allowance

- (1) The CIF Weight Wrestling Weight Management Program awards a two-pound growth allowance on January 15 of each wrestling season.

PLAYOFFS

A. CIFSDS Divisional Tournaments

- 1. Schools with wrestling teams will be divided into Division I, Division II, Division III, and Division IV.

2. Each divisional tournament will be planned for 16-person bracket for each weight class.
3. Awards
 - a. Medals to wrestlers
All Divisions
- **1st - 4th place plus ties for 5th place.**
 - b. CIF Awards to Championship and Runner-up team in each division.

2. TOURNAMENT INFORMATION

Coaches must provide a ROSTER with SEEDING INFORMATION no later than 8:00pm on Tuesday, May 25.

- NOTE: Using Microsoft Word or Google Docs, include the following info:
 - **For ALL Wrestlers:** Weight Class, Wrestler's Name (first and last), and Grade
 - **Only for Wrestlers Who Should Be Seeded:** 2021 Record, and ALL tournament placings for this season and last season.

Coaches must also bring copies of the following documents to the Seeding Meeting on Wednesday, May 26, or email them to the tournament director prior to the meeting:

- **CERTIFICATION OF AUTHORIZED PERSONNEL**
 - NOTE: Complete a separate form for each credentialed coach. This form is also posted on the Boys Wrestling page at cifsds.org.
- **DESIGNATED SPECTATOR LIST**
 - NOTE: Each wrestler is allowed two immediate family members only
- **NWCA OFFICIAL WEIGH-IN REPORT**
 - NOTE: This is the weigh in form you print from Trackwrestling.com prior to each competition.

Coaches must also email a copy of the COVID Tests and Results for each athlete NO LATER than 8:00pm on Friday, May 28.

- NOTE: The tests must be given, and the results received, within 48-hours of the competition. This means your athletes MUST be tested on either Thursday or Friday. Either type of COVID test is okay as long as you receive the results in time. There is no specific form that you must use, but make sure that your information can be authenticated by the organization providing the tests and/or your school's Athletic Director.

All divisional tournaments are Saturday, May 29, 2021.

THE PENALTY FOR MISSING THE SUBMISSION DEADLINE WILL BE NON-PARTICIPATION BY COACH IN (1) DISCUSSION AND (2) VOTING PRIVILEGES AT SEEDING MEETING.

NOTES: Cross bracket in consolation quarters. Wrestlers who lose an out-bracket match must be included in the consolation rounds (It is double elimination for all wrestlers). The total number of consolation rounds per division will be determined by the total number of placers/qualifiers (plus, if necessary, the match for the divisional alternate).

- Medal 1st – 4th and award a tie for 5th
- Use two mats to run 1st and 3rd place matches simultaneously
- Some 3rd place matches may not be wrestled because of the 5-Match Rule. If needed, use established criteria (listed in the “CIF Wrestling Championship Bulletin”) to determine 3rd place and 4th place.
- Split the finals into two groups: (1) the first 7 weights, and (2) the last 7 weights. Wrestlers and observers from Group 1 must exit the gym before the wrestlers and observers from Group 2 enter the gym.

NOTE: WEIGH-INS CONDUCTED BY TEAM. **ALL TEAMS MUST BE IN THE WEIGH-IN AREA BY 7:00 A.M. ON SATURDAY – NO EXCEPTIONS** (AS PER STATE CIF AND NFHS RULES). IT IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE COACHES TO UNDERSTAND AND ADHERE TO THESE RULES.

- E. ALL CREDENTIALLED COACHES MUST CHECK IN AT REGISTRATION TABLES WITH PROPER IDENTIFICATION TO RECEIVE THEIR COACHES' PASSES. EACH INDIVIDUAL COACH MUST CHECK IN TO RECEIVE A PASS – UP TO FIVE (5) COACHES MAXIMUM PER TEAM.**

THE HEAD COACH MUST PRESENT THE LIST OF CREDENTIALLED COACHES, SIGNED BY THE ATHLETIC DIRECTOR OR PRINCIPAL, AT THE DIVISIONALS IN ORDER TO RECEIVE COACHES PASSES AT THE TOURNAMENTS.

- F. Proper Press Credential/Working Media/CIFSDS Press passes will be honored for floor access at the discretion of the tournament directors. There will be no press/photography floor access to middle area mats.**

2. SPECIAL NOTICES

In regard to the potential of a 6th match in a day for the divisional, it was determined that the rule book was clear on the point placement for wrestlers. In the event of a tie, the following criterion was agreed upon by the tournament directors:

1. If a wrestler has not had five matches, then he will be declared the winner if his opponent has reached the five-match limit (by rule).
2. Head-to-Head competition.
3. Common Opponent results.
4. Most falls.
5. Fewest points allowed.
6. Most match points scored.
7. Total mat time, including all wins and losses.

4. Weigh-in Rules (for CIF Divisional Tournaments)

- A. THE TRACKWRESTLING OFFICIAL WEIGH IN REPORT TEAM FORM MUST BE SUBMITTED PRIOR TO WEIGH-INS.**
- B. Coaches **will be allowed** in the weigh-in room at the **Divisional tournaments** (if there is adequate room for both wrestlers and coaches), but they are **not allowed** in the designated area where the scales are located.
- C. All wrestlers will be weighed in by team.
- D. If a wrestler does not make weight, attempting twice on an initial scale, then he may challenge any/all other official scales, being used for CIF Divisional weigh-ins, only once on each scale.
- E. If a wrestler does not make weight, the tournament officials will ask the coach if he wants to move a wrestler up in weight. All changes must be done prior to certification of that weight and announcing the next weight class.
- F. Weigh-ins shall begin at the designated time and conclude when the last team has been certified. Any wrestler NOT in the weigh-in room at the designated start time will be disqualified – **NO EXCEPTIONS**. It is the **COACHES' RESPONSIBILITY** to understand and adhere to these NFHS rules.

5. OFFICIALS

Match officials will be assigned by Mark Dexter, SDWOA and, IVWOA.

6. NON-FOOD CONCESSION
