Friday, April 23 is a school day and Granite Hills students and staff will be on campus. Please be respectful and access the pool facility by traversing the access road between the dirt lot and the Gymnasium.

Parking:

Friday during the school day- On-campus parking available in the large dirt lot west of the Stadium. Street parking limited. Please do not park at any other on-campus parking lots.

Friday after 4:00 pm and all-day Saturday. On-campus parking available in all lots. School busses please park on the street or in the dirt parking lot.

Student Athletes & Coaches:

Entry through the outside gate just west of the main pool gate.

Team staging area - Solar panel covered area west of the pool. Bring pop-ups, ground cover, etc.

Athlete entry/exit - Southwest pool gate. Potentially southeast gate as well.

State and County COVID response guidelines limit our allowable on-deck capacity. Athletes may come on deck as needed for adequate warm-up, swim, and warm-down time. Athletes will need to stay in the team staging area at all other times.

Restroom facilities for athletes will be on deck.

Restroom facilities for coaches will be off deck on the East side of the pool facility.

The snack bar will be open with an on-deck window.

The areas at the turn end of the pool, with the exception of the 500-freestyle lap-counters, will need to remain clear so as to not block spectator viewing.

Spectators:

Spectator staging area will be on the grass field between the dirt lot and the Baseball field. This is an unshaded area. Pop-ups, umbrellas, lawn chairs, blankets, etc. are encouraged.

State and County COVID response guidelines will be in force, including wearing a mask while on deck. Those guidelines also limit our allowable on-deck capacity. It is probable that we will enforce a system allowing spectators to come on deck to view the swim of their athlete and then return to an off-deck location. Those spectators with proof of full vaccination may stay on deck.

Restroom facilities are off deck on the East side of the pool facility. Restroom facilities may also be available in the building just north of the pool facility. (Tentative at this time)

The snack bar may be accessed through the east window (off deck).

There is no charge to attend the event this year. However, in alignment with the California Department of Public Health Guidance for Outdoor Events, we will need to limit the number of spectators with access to the Pool Deck. Each student athlete will be permitted to have 4 Household members present for each event in which they participate.
